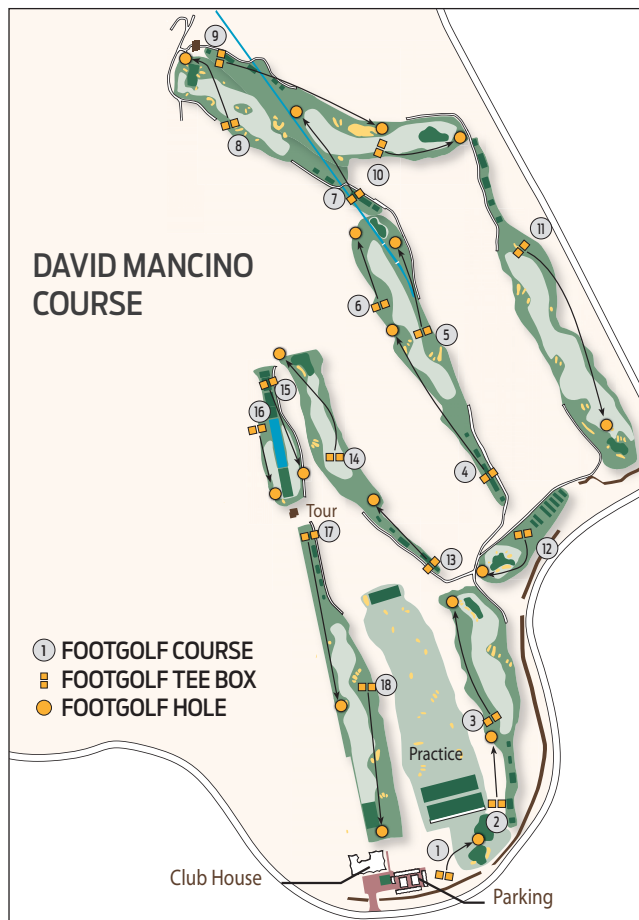

FOOTGOLF LOCAL RULES

1. The player who takes the least amount of kicks for the determined round or rounds wins the tournament.
2. Every player shall start his round at the time determined by the tournament committee. It is not acceptable to be late and penalty strokes will be given if you are not at the tee within 5 minutes of your tee time.
3. After EACH hole the marker will check the score of the player he is marking. Once the round has ended and all cards are correctly and clearly completed, they should be signed by both player and marker and IMMEDIATELY handed in to the collection point. Every player is responsible for his own card. After the card is signed it is not allowed to be modified. The penalty for this is disqualification.
4. All balls landing in the bunker shall be kicked out by a standing kick and that player is responsible for raking the ball marks and his foot prints.
5. If a ball is hit by another ball in the playing area, (fairway or rough), the player whose ball it is that is hit must replace it to its original position. The ball that makes the collision is played from its finishing position. All balls shall be marked when on the green.
6. There is no 3 or 10 second rule and any ball not marked will be played from its eventual lie.
7. Out of bounds are defined by white or orange stakes. Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes. Lateral hazards are defined by red stakes.
8. All stakes are movable should they be in your direct route to the hole, but must be replaced if so moved.
9. All "Golf" greens are in play.
10. Proper Footgolf etiquette should be adhered to at all times.

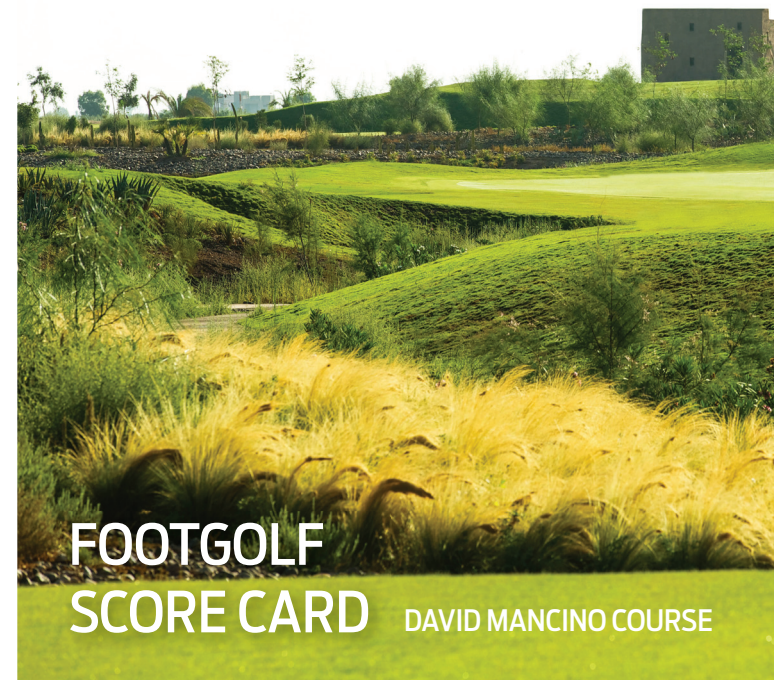
